

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 444-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 "(c) This section shall not prohibit a specialty
- 4 contractor from taking and executing a contract involving the
- 5 use of two or more crafts or trades, if the performance of the
- 6 work in the crafts or trades, other than in which the specialty
- 7 contractor is licensed, is incidental and supplemental [to the
- 8 performance of] work [in the craft for which the specialty
- 9 contractor is licensed].
- 10 For purposes of this subsection, "incidental and
- 11 supplemental work" means work done in other trades directly
- 12 related to and necessary for the completion of the project
- 13 undertaken by a specialty contractor licensee pursuant to the
- 14 scope of the licensee's license; provided that the work shall
- 15 not exceed more than five per cent of the specialty contractor
- 16 licensee's total work on the project."
- 17 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
