

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MINIMUM WAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) Except as provided in section 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each employee employed by the 5 employer, wages at the rate of not less than: 6 (1)\$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; 7 (2) \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007; 8 (3) \$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; 9 (4)10 (5) \$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; 11 (6) \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; [and] 12 \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018[-]; (7) \$11.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2023; 13 (8) 14 (9) \$12.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2024; 15 (10)\$13.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2025; 16 (11)\$14.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2026; 17 (12)\$15.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2027;
