

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MINIMUM WAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
3	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
4	"(b) The hourly wage of a tipped employee may be deemed to
5	be increased on account of tips if the employee is paid not less
6	than:
7	(1) 25 cents;
8	(2) 50 cents per hour beginning January 1, 2015; [and]
9	(3) 75 cents per hour beginning January 1, 2016[τ]:
10	(4) 50 cents per hour beginning January 1, 2023; and
11	(5) 25 cents per hour beginning January 1, 2024, through
12	December 31, 2024,
13	below the applicable minimum wage by the employee's employer and
14	the combined amount the employee receives from the employee's
15	employer and in tips is at least 50 cents more than the
16	applicable minimum wage; provided that beginning January 1,
17	2015, the combined amount the employee receives from the

- 1 employee's employer and in tips is at least \$7.00 more than the
- 2 applicable minimum wage."
- 3 PART II
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 387-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended as follows:
- 6 1. By amending the definition of "wage" to read:
- 7 ""Wage" means (except as the department may provide under
- 8 section 387-11) legal tender of the United States or checks on
- 9 banks convertible into cash on demand at full face value thereof
- 10 and in addition thereto the reasonable cost as determined by the
- 11 department, to the employer of furnishing an employee with
- 12 board, lodging, or other facilities if such board, lodging, or
- 13 other facilities are customarily furnished by such employer to
- 14 the employer's employees. [Except for the purposes of the last
- 15 sentence of section 387-2, "wage" | "Wage" shall not include tips
- 16 or gratuities of any kind."
- 17 2. By deleting the definition of "tipped employee".
- 18 [""Tipped employee" means any employee engaged in an
- 19 occupation in which the employee customarily and regularly
- 20 receives more than \$20 a month in tips."]

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         SECTION 3. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
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    amended to read as follows:
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         "$387-2 Minimum waqes. [<del>(a)</del>] Except as provided in
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    section 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each
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    employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less

- 9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022;
- 10 provided that part II shall take effect on January 1, 2025.
