### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DENTAL ASSISTANTS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to allow dental			
2	assistants to perform limited, $\epsilon$ ssential duties under the			
3	general supervision of a dentist in public health settings.			
4	SECTION 2. Chapter 448, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
5	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated			
6	and to read as follows:			
7	" <u>§448-</u> <u>Supervision in public health settings.</u> (a) A			
8	dental assistant may operate under the supervision of any			
9	licensed dentist providing support dental services in a public			
10	health setting.			
11	(b) General supervision shall be permitted in a public			
12	health setting; provided that:			
13	(1) The supervising licensed dentist is available for			
14	<pre>consultation;</pre>			
15	(2) The dental assistant is working directly with a			
16	licensed dental hygierist; and			

1	(3)	The supervising licensed dental hygienist is under the				
2		supervision of a licensed dentist.				
3	(c)	A dental assistant working under the general				
4	supervisi	ion of a licensed dentist and the direct supervision of				
5	a license	icensed dental hygienist who is under the supervision of a				
6	licensed	licensed dentist may perform the following supportive dental				
7	procedures:					
8	(1)	Taking intra-oral and extra-oral photographs, and				
9		recording or charting clinical findings as directed by				
10		the licensed dental hygienist;				
11	(2)	Exposing, processing, mounting, and labeling				
12		radiographs;				
13	(3)	Measuring and recording vital signs;				
14	(4)	Assisting the licensed dental hygienist who is				
15		performing a dental procedure on a patient, such as:				
16		(A) Preparing procedural trays and armamentaria;				
17		(B) Retracting a patient's oral tissues to maintain				
18		the field of operation during a dental procedure;				
19		(C) Removing debris, as is normally created and				
20		accumulated during or after dental procedures by				
21		the dental hygienist; and

1		(D)	Transferring dental instruments or any other
2			concept of four-handed dentistry the dental
3			hygienist requires to perform the procedure; and
4	(5)	Assi	sting the licensed dental hygienist in the
5		perf	ormance of the duties of the dental hygienist as
6		requ	ested; provided that the assistance does not
7		incl	ude procedures listed in Hawaii Administrative
8		Rule	s, sections 16-79-69.5 and 16-79-69.10;
9	provided	that	the dental assistant, licensed dental hygienist,
10	and licen	sed d	entist are providing dental services in a public
11	health se	tting	<u>.</u>
12	(d)	The	supervising licensed dentist shall be responsible
13	for all d	elega	ted acts performed by the dental assistant.
14	<u>(e)</u>	As u	sed in this section, "public health setting" has
15	the same	meani	ng as defined in section 447-3."
