A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL GARDENS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that establishing a
2	school garden coordinator position placed within the department
3	of education's office of curriculum and instructional design is
4	needed to successfully implement the following purposes of the
5	Hawaii farm to school program, as set forth by Act 175, Session
6	Laws of Hawaii 2021:
7	(1) Improving student health;

- 9 (3) Accelerating garden and farm-based education for10 public school students.
- The legislature further finds that the increased use of
 learning gardens and farms on school campuses across the State
 plays a central role in protecting student health, recovering
 and advancing academic achievement, and strengthening socialemotional well-being. The farm to school program seeks to
 equitably improve learning, mental and physical health, and

happiness for children and adults through the increased use of

- 1 outdoor educational spaces. The program also reduces the burden
- 2 on indoor classrooms while providing fresh air, hands-on
- 3 learning opportunities, and the health benefits associated with
- 4 increased access to nature. A national study of nearly twenty
- 5 thousand participants revealed that spending two or more hours
- 6 per week in nature, either all at once or cumulatively, is
- 7 definitively linked with better health and well-being.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to establish and fund a school
- 9 garden coordinator position, within the department of
- 10 education's office of curriculum and instructional design, to
- 11 provide technical support and startup resources for schools
- 12 interested in starting a school garden program.
- 13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000 or so much
- 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for one
- 16 full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) permanent school garden
- 17 coordinator position to be placed within the department of
- 18 education's office of curriculum and instructional design;
- 19 provided that the funds may also be used for expenses related to
- 20 the provision of technical support and startup resources for
- 21 schools interested in starting a school garden program.

- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
