A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 206E-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) The authority shall consist of the director of 4 finance, or the director's designee; the director of 5 transportation, or the director's designee; the director of 6 business, economic development, and tourism, or the director's 7 designee; the director of planning and permitting of each county 8 in which a community development district is located, or the 9 director's designee; a cultural specialist; [an at-large 10 member; an at-large member nominated by the [senate] 11 president[+] of the senate; an at-large member nominated by the 12 speaker of the house[+] of representatives; [three] two 13 representatives of the Heeia community development district, 14 comprising [two residents] one resident of that district or the 15 Koolaupoko district, which consists of sections 1 through 9 of 16 zone 4 of the first tax map key division, and one owner of a 17 small business or one officer or director of a nonprofit

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1 organization in the Heeia community development district or 2 Koolaupoko district[, nominated by the county council of the county in which the Heeia community development district is 3 located]; [three] two representatives of the Kalaeloa community 4 5 development district, comprising [two residents] one resident of 6 the Ewa zone (zone 9, sections 1 through 2) or the Waianae zone 7 (zone 8, sections 1 through 9) of the first tax map key 8 division, and one owner of a small business or one officer or 9 director of a nonprofit organization in the Ewa or Waianae 10 zone [, nominated by the county council of the county in which 11 the Kalaeloa community development district is located]; [three] 12 two representatives of the Kakaako community development 13 district, comprising [two residents] one resident of the 14 district and one owner of a small business or one officer or 15 director of a nonprofit organization in the district[, nominated 16 by the county council of the county in which the Kakaako 17 community development district is located; the director of 18 planning and permitting of each county in which a community 19 development district is located or the director's designee, who 20 shall serve in an ex officio, nonvoting capacity, and the 21 chairperson of the Hawaiian homes commission or the

1 chairperson's designee, who shall serve in an ex officio, 2 nonvoting capacity]. 3 All members, except the director of finance $[\tau]$; director of 4 transportation $[\tau]$; director of business, economic development, 5 and tourism, and county directors of planning and permitting, 6 [and chairperson of the Hawaiian homes commission] or their 7 designees, shall be appointed by the governor pursuant to section 26-34. The two at-large members nominated by the 8 9 [senate] president of the senate and speaker of the house [and 10 the nine representatives of the respective community development 11 districts] of representatives shall each be appointed by the 12 governor from a list of three nominees submitted for each 13 position by the nominating authority specified in this 14 subsection. The president of the senate and the speaker of the 15 house of representatives shall each submit a list of three 16 nominees for each district to the governor to fill the two 17 district representative positions for each community development 18 district. Of the nominees for each community development

district, one nominee shall meet the district residency

requirement, and one nominee shall meet the district small

business owner or nonprofit organization officer or director

15	In the ev	ent of a vacancy, a member shall be appointed to	
16	fill the vacan	cy in the same manner as the original appointment	
17	within thirty	days of the vacancy or within ten days of the	
18	senate's rejec	tion of a previous appointment, as applicable.	
19	The terms	of the director of finance[7]; director of	
20	transportation	[7]; director of the business, economic	
21	development, a	nd tourism, and county directors of planning and	

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- 1 permitting, [and chairperson of the Hawaiian homes commission]
- 2 or their respective designees, shall run concurrently with each
- 3 official's term of office. The terms of the appointed voting
- 4 members shall be for four years, commencing on July 1 and
- 5 expiring on June 30[; provided that the initial terms of all
- 6 voting members initially appointed pursuant to Act 61, Session
- 7 Laws of Hawaii 2014, shall commence on March 1, 2015]. The
- 8 governor shall provide for staggered terms of the initially
- 9 appointed voting members so that the initial terms of four
- 10 members selected by lot shall be for two years, the initial
- 11 terms of four members selected by lot shall be for three years,
- 12 and the initial terms of the remaining five members shall be for
- 13 four years.
- 14 The governor may remove or suspend for cause any member
- 15 after due notice and public hearing.
- Notwithstanding section 92-15, a majority of all eligible
- 17 voting members as specified in this subsection shall constitute
- 18 a quorum to do business, and the concurrence of a majority of
- 19 all eligible voting members as specified in this subsection
- 20 shall be necessary to make any action of the authority valid.
- 21 All members shall continue in office until their respective

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- 1 successors have been appointed and qualified. Except as herein
- 2 provided, no member appointed under this subsection shall be an
- 3 officer or employee of the State or its political subdivisions.
- 4 [For purposes of] As used in this section, "small business"
- 5 means a business [which] that is independently owned and [which]
- 6 that is not dominant in its field of operation."
- 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Hawaii Community Development Authority; Nomination and Appointment of Representative Members

Description:

Amends the membership of the Hawaii community development authority by removing the county council as the nominating authority for the community development district representatives, removing one at-large member, reducing the number of district resident representatives, and making the director of planning and permitting of each county a voting, rather than a nonvoting, member. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD2)
