1 SECTION 1. Section 286-102.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[+] §286-102.5[+] Military Selective Service Act; 4 Selective Service System registration. (a) Qualified 5 applicants for a motor vehicle [+] driver's[+] license pursuant to section 286-107 or 286-108 or an instruction permit pursuant 6 to section 286-110 shall be registered with the United States 7 8 Selective Service System in compliance with [Title 50 United 9 States Code Appendix section 453, 50 U.S.C. §3802, as amended. 10 Every qualified applicant identified in subsection (a) 11 shall be required to authorize the examiner of drivers to: 12 Collect the necessary personal information required (1) 13 for registering the qualified applicant with the 14 United States Selective Service System; and 15 Electronically transmit the information to the (2) 16 Selective Service System pursuant to subsection (d)

3	(c) The examiner of drivers shall notify all qualified						
4	applicants identified in subsection (a) that by submitting an						
5	application, the qualified applicant is consenting to

8	(d) The examiner of drivers shall collect from a qualified						
9	applicant the necessary personal information required for						
10	registering the qualified applicant with the United States						
11	Selective Service System. The examiner of drivers shall						
12	transmit the necessary personal information of the qualified						
13	applicant in an electronic format to the United States Selective						
14	Service System to register the qualified applicant.						
15	(e) For purposes of this section, "qualified applicant"						
16	means [male] all United States citizens and immigrants at least						
17	eighteen years of age but less than twenty-six years of age."
