
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE, ITS
OFFICERS, OR ITS EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. The following sums or so much thereof as may be
3 necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 are appropriated out of the
4 general revenues of the State of Hawaii to the department of the
5 attorney general for the purpose of satisfying claims for
6 legislative relief as to the following named persons, firms,
7 corporations, and entities, for claims against the State or its
8 officers or employees for the overpayment of taxes, or for
9 refunds, reimbursements, payments of judgments or settlements,
10 or other liabilities, in the amounts set forth opposite their
11 names:

12 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
13 of the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.

14 PART II

15 SECTION 2. The sums hereinabove may be paid to the
16 respective persons, or for the satisfaction or settlement of the
17 respectively identified cases, and in several amounts
18 hereinabove set forth or in lesser amounts deemed appropriate,
19 upon checks issued by the comptroller; provided that departments
20 shall obtain the approval of the attorney general before payment
21 of any claim can be made.

22 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as
23 interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest
24 shall be limited to the period from the date of judgment, if
25 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this Act,



1 as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those
2 cases to which the statute applies.

3 SECTION 4. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
4 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
5 June 30, 2023, shall lapse.

6 SECTION 5. If any provision of this Act, or the
7 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
8 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
9 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
10 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
11 of this Act are severable.

12 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
