1	(5)	Effective July 1, 2022, all revenues, fees, and income
2		received by the department from its management of

6	(b)	The fund shall be used by the department to provide

8	(1)	A program to provide seed capital for film, media, and
9		creative industries intellectual property development
10		projects for export, as determined by the department;
11	(2)	Programs that expand the skills of the State's resident
12		workforce in the film, media, and creative industries;

14	(3)	Marketing programs that attract business opportunities
15		[within] \underline{in} the film, media, and creative industries

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii film

- 6 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
