- 7 SECTION 12. The fiscal year 2021-2022 appropriations or
- 8 authorized under this Act shall not lapse until the end of
- 9 fiscal biennium 2021-2023; provided that funds appropriated or
- 10 authorized by this Act that are not expended or encumbered by
- 11 June 30, 2023, shall lapse as of that date.
