**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

19 SECTION 14. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act  
20 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2023, shall  
21 lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
