# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. There are appropriated from the sources of  
3 funding indicated below to collective bargaining statewide (BUF  
4 102) the following sums or so much thereof as may be necessary  
5 to fund for fiscal year 2022-2023 all collective bargaining cost  
6 items in the reopener agreement negotiated with the exclusive  
7 representative of collective bargaining unit (13):

 17 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is  
 18 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds  
 19 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,  
 20 from the respective funds.



1 SECTION 14. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act  
2 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2023, shall  
3 lapse as of that date.

4 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect on December 25,  
5 2040.
