A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OPTIONS FOR STUDENTS IN DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide clarity
- 2 and consistency with regard to commercial enterprise activities
- 3 in schools by broadening the scope of profit-making operations
- 4 that students may engage in at schools to include commercial
- 5 enterprises, while ensuring that engagement in commercial
- 6 enterprises shall be related to the primary educational purposes
- 7 of the school, career pathway, academy, or program. This Act
- 8 will allow students to receive school credit, compensation, or
- 9 both, when engaging in profit-making operations.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 302A-420, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
