A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISES IN SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- ${f 1}$ SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to allow for greater
- 2 implementation of commercial enterprises in schools by:
- 3 (1) Deeming student interns engaged in commercial
- 4 enterprise to be employees of the State for liability
- 5 purposes; and
- **6** (2) Allowing the department of education to use revenue
- 7 from school commercial enterprises.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 302A-448, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- "[+]\$302A-448[+] Schools; career pathways, academies, and
- 11 programs; commercial enterprises. (a) Notwithstanding any law
- 12 to the contrary, an individual department school or any career
- 13 pathway, academy, or program operated within a school may engage
- 14 in commercial enterprises that are related to the primary
- 15 educational purposes of the school, career pathway, academy, or
- 16 program as set forth in this chapter, including the sale of

- 1 goods produced by or for an individual school, career pathway,
- 2 academy, or program.
- 3 (b) Student interns engaging in commercial enterprises
- 4 shall be considered employees of the State pursuant to chapter
- **5** 662.
- 6 (c) Revenues accrued and expenditures made by the
- 7 department for the operation of commercial enterprises,
- 8 including but not limited to hiring personnel, renovating
- 9 commercial space, and purchasing merchandise, supplies, and
- 10 equipment, shall be accrued and made without regard to chapters
- 11 76, 78, 89, 103, and 103D. Net profits generated pursuant to
- 12 this section and section 302A-1903, may be used by the
- department.
- 14 [\(\frac{(b)}{}\)] (d) The department may adopt rules pursuant to
- 15 chapter 91 to carry out the purposes of this section."
- 16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
