A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that surfing is of
 significant cultural, social, and economic value to the people
- 3 of Hawaii, as well as the many visitors who travel to the State
- 4 for surfing. The legislature recognizes the extraordinary
- 5 accomplishments of Carissa Moore a Palolo resident who won the
- 6 gold medal in the first ever women's surfing competition in the
- 7 Summer Olympic Games and the many other Hawaii surfers who
- $oldsymbol{8}$ have dedicated themselves to honoring and preserving the sport
- ${f 9}$ and spirit of surfing in Hawaii.
- 10 The legislature additionally finds that since surfing was
- 11 sanctioned by the department of education in 2004, only one of
- 12 five local athletic leagues have sponsored surfing. The lack of
- 13 interscholastic surfing programs limits opportunities for
- 14 inspired students to pursue competitive surfing.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 16 department of education to promote and support surfing as an
- 17 interscholastic sport.

1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for 3 the promotion and support of surfing as an interscholastic 5 sport. 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 7 education for the purposes of this Act. 8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050. 9
