A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RISK AND NEEDS ASSESSMENT FOR FEMALE OFFENDERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 353-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b)	The centers shall:
4	(1)	Provide orientation, guidance, and technical services;
5	(2)	Provide social-medical-psychiatric-psychological
6		diagnostic evaluation;
7	(3)	Conduct internal pretrial risk assessments on adult
8		offenders within three working days of admission to a
9		community correctional center; provided that this
10		paragraph shall not apply to persons subject to county
11		or state detainers or holds, persons detained without
12		bail, persons detained for probation violation,
13		persons facing revocation of bail or supervised
14		release, and persons who have had a pretrial risk
15		assessment completed prior to admission to a community
16		correctional center. For purposes of this paragraph,
17		"pretrial risk assessment" means an objective,

1	٠	research-based, validated assessment tool that
2		measures an offender's risk of flight, risk of
3		criminal conduct, and risk of violence or harm to any
4		person or the general public while on pretrial release
5		pending adjudication. The pretrial risk assessment
6		tool and procedures associated with its administration
7		shall be periodically reviewed and subject to further
8		validation at least every five years to evaluate the
9		effectiveness of the tool and the procedures
10		associated with its administration. The findings of
11		periodic reviews shall be publicly reported;
12	(4)	Conduct internal pretrial female risk and need
13		assessments on adult female offenders within three
14		working days of admission to a community correctional
15		center; provided that this paragraph shall not apply
16		to persons subject to county or state detainers or
17		holds, persons detained without bail, persons detained
18		for probation violation, persons facing revocation of
19		bail or supervised release, and persons who have had a
20		pretrial female risk and need assessment completed
21		prior to admission to a community correctional center.

	The pretrial female risk and needs assessment tool
	shall consider factors important to evaluate a woman's
	risk to reoffend, including but not limited to rates
	of physical and sexual abuse prior to becoming an
	offender, and a woman's specialized treatment needs.
	The pretrial female risk and needs assessment tool and
	procedures associated with its administration shall be
	periodically reviewed and subject to further
	validation at least every five years to evaluate the
	effectiveness of the tool and the procedures
	associated with its administration. The findings of
	periodic reviews shall be publicly reported.
	For purposes of this paragraph, "pretrial female
	risk and needs assessment" means an objective,
	research-based, validated assessment tool that
	measures a female offender's risk of flight, risk of
	criminal conduct, and risk of violence or harm to any
	person or the general public while on pretrial release
	pending adjudication;
[(4)]	(5) Provide correctional prescription program
	planning and security classification;

13		department of public safety's pretrial services
14		officers shall be provided limited access for the
15		purpose of viewing other state agencies' relevant data

18	[(9)]	(10) Provide pretrial bail reports to the courts on
19		adult offenders, within three working days of
20		admission of the offender to a community correctional
21		center, that are ordered by the court or consented to

1	by the offender. A complete copy of the executed
2	pretrial risk assessment delineating the scored items,
3	the total score, any administrative scoring overrides
4	applied, and written explanations for administrative
5	scoring overrides, shall be included in the pretrial
6	bail report. The pretrial bail reports shall be
7	confidential and shall not be deemed to be public
8	records. A copy of a pretrial bail report shall be
9	provided only:
10	(A) To the defendant or defendant's counsel;
11	(B) To the prosecuting attorney;
12	(C) To the department of public safety;
13	(D) To any psychiatrist, psychologist, or other
14	treatment practitioner who is treating the
15	defendant pursuant to a court order;
16	(E) Upon request, to the adult client services
17	branch; and
18	(F) In accordance with applicable laws, persons, or
19	entities doing research. The research entity
20	must be approved and contracted by the department
21	of public safety to protect the confidentiality

1	of the information, insofar as the information is

Requires the department of public safety to develop a pretrial female risk and needs assessment tool and conduct internal pretrial female risk and needs assessments to measure the female offender's risk of flight, criminal conduct, or harm to the community. Requires the pretrial female risk and needs assessment tool to consider factors important to women when considering their risk to reoffend and treatment needs. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
