## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MENTAL HEALTH LICENSING.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Asian Americans,
- 2 native Hawaiians, Pacific Islanders, and other persons of color
- 3 experience disparities in mental health care. Members of
- 4 minority communities suffer from high rates of depression,
- 5 trauma, and mental illness but may be unlikely to access mental
- 6 health services. The legislature recognizes that a fear of
- 7 receiving culturally insensitive or culturally inappropriate
- 8 treatment can be a barrier to seeking help. The legislature
- 9 also recognizes that an individual's culture can influence the
- 10 symptomatic expression of mental illness, making cultural
- 11 competence critical for accurate diagnoses and effective care.
- 12 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require
- 13 psychologists licensed in the State to complete at least three
- 14 hours of continuing education per licensing biennium on topics
- 15 relating to cultural diversity, cultural competence, or health
- 16 equity.
