
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE DRUG AND ALCOHOL TOXICOLOGY TESTING
LABORATORY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 196, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021 (Act 196),
2 established the state drug and alcohol toxicology testing
3 laboratory special fund to support a state drug and alcohol
4 toxicology testing laboratory; specified that moneys in the
5 state highway fund may be expended for the cost of establishing
6 a state drug and alcohol toxicology testing laboratory; required
7 that fines imposed on offenders convicted of certain offenses
8 involving operating a vehicle under the influence of an
9 intoxicant be deposited into the state drug and alcohol
10 toxicology testing laboratory special fund; and required the
11 department of health to submit reports to the legislature on
12 expenditures from the state drug and alcohol toxicology testing
13 laboratory special fund.

14 Act 196 also provided that the state drug and alcohol
15 toxicology testing laboratory special fund shall be abolished
16 and repealed on June 30, 2026, and any unencumbered remaining



1 balances shall lapse to the general fund. Act 196 did not
2 appropriate moneys from the state highway fund to be deposited
3 into the state drug and alcohol testing laboratory special fund,
4 nor did Act 196 appropriate state drug and alcohol testing
5 laboratory special funds for the establishment of a state drug
6 and alcohol toxicology testing laboratory.

7 The purpose of this Act is to:

8 (1) Appropriate moneys from the state highway fund to the
9 department of health's state drug and alcohol
10 toxicology testing laboratory special fund for fiscal
11 year 2022-2023; and

12 (2) Authorize the department of health to expend funds
13 from the state drug and alcohol toxicology testing
14 laboratory special fund for the establishment of the
15 state drug and alcohol toxicology testing laboratory.

16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the state highway
17 fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be
18 necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to be deposited into the
19 state drug and alcohol toxicology testing laboratory special
20 fund established by Act 196, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021.



1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the state drug and
2 alcohol toxicology testing laboratory special fund the sum of
3 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
4 year 2022-2023 for the establishment of a state drug and alcohol
5 toxicology testing laboratory, including the costs of laboratory
6 instrumentation, facility renovation and security upgrades,
7 office furniture and supplies, laboratory equipment, and other
8 purposes that support a state drug and alcohol toxicology
9 testing laboratory.

10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
11 health for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 4. Any provision of this Act to the contrary
13 notwithstanding, the appropriation authorized under this Act
14 shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the
15 appropriation is made. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance
16 of the appropriations made in this Act as of the close of
17 business on June 30, 2023, shall lapse back to the credit of the
18 state highway fund.

19 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2060.
