A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that permitting post

office box and rural and highway contract route box addresses to

be used as an option for prescriptions, as long as the physical

location where an individual resides is on file, would provide

more efficiency for pharmacists in having prescriptions reach

6 consumers, rather than requiring consumers to take the required

7 steps to change the post office box and rural and highway

 $oldsymbol{8}$ contract route box address to a physical address. The

 ${f 9}$ legislature further finds that making this change would promote

more efficiency and effectiveness in the timely delivery of

11 prescriptions to consumers.

12 The purpose of this Act is to amend the definition of

13 "address" in the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, chapter 329,

14 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to make post office boxes and rural and

15 highway contract route boxes permissible for a prescription to

16 be considered valid, on the condition that a physical address is

17 readily accessible.

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 329-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "address" to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 ""Address" means, with respect to prescriptions, the
- 5 physical location where an individual resides, such as:
- 6 (1) Street address, city, and state;
- 7 (2) Tax map key number; or
- **8** (3) The description of a physical location.
- 9 Unless the context dictates otherwise, "address" includes a post
- 10 office box; provided that the pharmacy dispensing the
- 11 prescription has the physical location where an individual
- 12 resides on file."
- 13 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Allows post office boxes and rural and highway contract route boxes to be permissible for a prescription to be considered valid, only if a physical address where an individual resides is on file with the dispensing pharmacy. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
