
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-NINTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$139,995,500 or so much
thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2022-2023
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
ninth representative district, as follows:

1. Campbell high school

Design and construction for the
athletic facilities project; ground and
site improvements; equipment and
appurtenances.

15 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
16 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
17 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
18 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
19 of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.


20 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
