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### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENTS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State's
- 2 environmental review process was incorporated into the planning
- 3 processes of the State and counties to balance environmental
- 4 concerns with technical considerations and economic goals. The
- 5 legislature further finds that the State, stakeholders, and the
- 6 public all benefit from public participation and transparency in
- 7 the environmental review process.
- 8 However, the legislature recognizes that the public is
- 9 often unaware of a pending project until a determination is made
- 10 regarding an environmental assessment or environmental impact
- 11 statement, at which point the opportunity for public comment has
- 12 passed. Supporting public participation in projects prior to
- 13 acceptance of an environmental assessment or environmental
- 14 impact statement will foster greater awareness of and
- 15 participation in the environmental review process.
- 16 The legislature also finds that although the office of
- 17 planning and sustainable development currently has a website

- 1 that provides information to the public, the information
- 2 provided on the site is not user-friendly. Information is
- 3 difficult to locate and the site does not highlight pending
- 4 environmental assessments or environmental impact statements
- 5 that are currently open for public comments.
- 6 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the
- 7 office of planning and sustainable development to establish,
- 8 implement, and maintain an interactive website that is
- 9 accessible by the public at no cost and provides notification of
- 10 and opportunity for participation in actions taken pursuant to
- 11 the State's environmental review process.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 343-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- "\$343-3 Public records and notice[-]; office website. (a)
- 15 All statements, environmental assessments, and other documents
- 16 prepared under this chapter shall be made available for
- 17 inspection by the public during established office hours.
- 18 (b) The office shall inform the public of notices filed by
- 19 agencies of the availability of environmental assessments for
- 20 review and comments, of determinations that statements are
- 21 required or not required, of the availability of statements for
