A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with article VII, section 9, of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$99,433,565 or so
- 6 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 and
- 7 the sum of \$71,000,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary
- 8 for fiscal year 2022-2023 for coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic
- 9 mitigation, including vaccinations, distribution of supplies,
- 10 testing, monitoring, reporting, and related staffing.
- 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 12 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
