## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII CORRECTIONAL INDUSTRIES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 354D-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "**§354D-6 Required programs.** (a) The administrator shall  
4 establish programs that provide essential products and services  
5 for each of the State's correctional facilities, for other state  
6 agencies, and for the counties, as may be required.

7           (b) To the extent that inventories and equipment for  
8 specific services may be dedicated to the development of  
9 correctional industries, the director may transfer the  
10 supervision of inventory and equipment to the administrator.

11           (c) A portion of real property at each correctional  
12 facility shall be designated by the director as an industry  
13 area. The director may assign these facilities to the  
14 administrator who shall be responsible for the maintenance and  
15 upkeep of the areas.

16           (d) The director or a designated representative may  
17 consult with the administrator of the state procurement office



1 to identify goods or services [~~which~~] that the correctional  
2 industries program may produce or provide to any state  
3 agency~~[-]~~; provided that any goods provided by the program shall  
4 be:

- 5 (1) Produced or manufactured by the program; or
- 6 (2) Pre-existing goods that are substantially altered or  
7 customized by the program for the purpose of  
8 facilitating use of the goods by a state agency.

9 (e) The administrator of the state procurement office  
10 shall provide a list of goods and services available from the  
11 correctional industries program, and any state agency may  
12 purchase these goods and services from the correctional  
13 industries program."

14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
16 begun before its effective date.

17 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.

**Report Title:**

Corrections; Goods; Procurement; Manufacture; Production
