

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTY-THIRD REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue general obligation bonds in the sum of \$50,500,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-third representative district, as follows:

16 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
17 shall be expended by the department of education.

18 4. Papahana o Kaiona, Waianae, Oahu
19 Land, design, construction, and
20 equipment for an alternative learning
21 program facility.

19 6. Farrington highway, Oahu



1 Design and construction for repair of
2 mauka sidewalks along Farrington
3 highway.

4 Design \$1,500,000

5 Construction \$15,000,000

6 Total funding \$16,500,000

7 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
8 shall be expended by the department of transportation.

9 7. Farrington highway, Oahu

10 Design and construction for widening of
11 Farrington highway from Helelua street
12 to Mohihi street.

13 Design \$2,000,000

14 Construction \$25,000,000

15 Total funding \$27,000,000

16 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
17 shall be expended by the department of transportation.

18 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
19 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
20 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;



1 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
2 of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
