1 SECTION 1. Section 378-2.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 No employer shall enter into or require an employee 4 to enter into[, as a condition of employment,] a nondisclosure 5 agreement that prevents the employee from disclosing or 6 discussing sexual harassment or sexual assault occurring in the 7 workplace, at work-related events, between employees, or between 8 an employer and an employee." SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 9 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 12
