
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING PUBLIC UTILITIES TO PROVIDE A FIFTY PERCENT RATE
DISCOUNT TO RETIRED SENIOR CITIZENS.

1 WHEREAS, many retired senior citizens live on fixed incomes
2 and tight budgets, requiring them to limit expenses; and
3

4 WHEREAS, the costs of public utilities, including
5 electricity, water, gas, telephone, and telecommunication
6 services are consistently rising and are difficult to limit or
7 negotiate; and
8

9 WHEREAS, the widening gaps between the rising costs of
10 public utility services and fixed incomes of retired senior
11 citizens make it increasingly difficult for retired senior
12 citizens to live within their budgets; and

14 WHEREAS, proactive measures are needed to help retired
15 senior citizens maintain a reasonable quality of life despite
16 rising, but necessary, public utility expenses; now, therefore,

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
19 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
20 of 2022, that any public utility having a certificate of public
21 convenience and necessity issued by the Public Utilities
22 Commission is requested to provide a fifty percent rate discount
23 to any customer who is a retired senior citizen; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Public Utilities Commission
26 is requested to assess the actions taken by public utilities and
27 to determine whether any additional legislation is needed to
28 ensure that retired senior citizens receive fifty percent rate
29 discounts; and

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Public Utilities Commission
32 is requested to submit a report of its findings and
33 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
34 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
35 the Regular Session of 2023; and
