## HOUSE RESOLUTION

---

URGING THE SUPERINTENDENT OF EDUCATION TO REQUEST THE BOARD OF  
EDUCATION TO HONOR MCKINLEY HIGH SCHOOL'S 132 FALLEN  
SOLDIERS BY SAFEGUARDING AND PRESERVING THE NAME OF  
MCKINLEY HIGH SCHOOL.

1 WHEREAS, established in 1865 as Fort Street English Day  
2 School, McKinley High School is one of the oldest secondary  
3 schools in the Hawaiian islands; and

5 WHEREAS, McKinley High School has a long history of  
6 producing leaders and forerunners for Hawaii that has  
7 contributed to the growth and success of the State and the  
8 nation; and

10 WHEREAS, the Second World War proved to be a challenge for  
11 the students and alumni of McKinley High School, as many were  
12 called for duty in service to their country to do their part in  
13 the nation's war effort; and

16 name of McKinley High School, to honor McKinley High School's  
17 132 Fallen Soldiers, who valiantly served our nation with

11 WHEREAS, the strong will and distinction displayed by the  
12 soldiers of McKinley High School will never be forgotten, but  
13 the efforts of the students of McKinley High School, who at the  
14 time provided economic support with two war bond drives to  
15 purchase over \$200,000 in bonds and stamps and then raised  
16 another \$333,000 to purchase a B-24 Liberator bomber, named  
17 Madame Pele, for the United States Air Force, will always be  
18 remembered; and

19  
20 WHEREAS, from a cultural heritage standpoint, it's the  
21 State's duty and obligation to honor the legacy of the school  
22 that had educated and instilled the traditions and pride into  
23 all students and alumni, and especially to the men who  
24 volunteered and enlisted as soldiers to the war efforts of World  
25 War II; and

27 WHEREAS, the name McKinley High School will memorialize  
28 these remains, many of whom are laid to rest at the National  
29 Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific overlooking McKinley High  
30 School, and for those who were buried on foreign land and never  
31 returned home; now, therefore,

33 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
34 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
35 of 2022, that the Superintendent Education is emphatically urged  
36 to request the Board of Education to preserve the name of  
37 McKinley High School and its rich history to honor the legacy of  
38 its alumni, the "Greatest Generation", for their loyal service  
39 and ultimate sacrifice during World War II; and
