A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MINIMUM WAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Except as provided in section 387-9 and this section, 4 every employer shall pay to each employee employed by the 5 employer, wages at the rate of not less than: 6 (1) \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; 7 (2) \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; 8 (3) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007; 9 \$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; (4) 10 \$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; (5) 11 \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; [and] (6) 12 (7) \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018[-]; 13 \$12.00 per hour beginning October 1, 2022; (8) 14 (9) \$15.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2024; and 15 \$18.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2026." (10)16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
