A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EARLY LEARNING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302L-1.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows: 3 "(b) The board shall consist of the following voting 4 members: 5 (1) A representative of center-based program providers or 6 the representative's designee; 7 (2) A representative of family child care program 8 providers; 9 (3) A representative of family-child interaction learning 10 program providers; 11 (4)A representative of philanthropic organizations that 12 support early learning or the representative's 13 designee; 14 (5) A representative from a head start provider agency; A representative from the Hawaii Early Intervention 15 (6) 16 Coordinating Council; 17 (7) A parent representative;

2		American Academy of Pediatrics;	
3	(9)	A representative of home-visiting program providers;	
4	(10)	A representative of Hawaiian medium early learning	
5		providers; and

10	The superintendent of education, director of human		
11	services,	director of health, and president of the University of	
12	Hawaii shall serve as ex officio, nonvoting members of the		
13	board.		
14	The	board shall invite the chief executive officer of	
15	Kamehameha Schools and the executive director of the Hawaii		
16	Association of Independent Schools, or their designees, to serve		
17	as voting members of the board.		
18	(c)	Except for the superintendent of education, directors	
19	of state	departments, president of the University of Hawaii,	
20	chief executive officer of Kamehameha Schools, and the executive		
21	director	of the Hawaii Association of Independent Schools, or
