A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FISHING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 188-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending its title and subsection (a) to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 "§188-23 Possession or use of explosives, electrofishing
- 5 devices, unmanned aerial vehicles, and poisonous substances in
- 6 state waters prohibited; exception. (a) It is unlawful to
- 7 possess or use on, in, or near state waters, any explosives,
- 8 electrofishing devices, [or] any source of electrical energy
- 9 with appurtenant devices for the introduction of electricity
- 10 into the water, or unmanned aerial vehicles, for the purpose of
- 11 taking aquatic life, except under the terms and conditions of a
- 12 permit first obtained by the user from the department. The
- 13 department may issue permits for the possession or use of
- 14 electrofishing devices or unmanned aerial vehicles consistent
- 15 with other legal requirements. For the purposes of this
- 16 subsection:

1 "Unmanned aerial vehicle" means any aerial vehicle that is 2 operated without the possibility of direct human intervention within or on the aerial vehicle. The term "unmanned aerial 3 4 vehicle" does not include a remote-controlled airplane. "Remote controlled airplane" means a small aircraft, 5 usually made of cardboard, foam, or other flimsy and 6 insubstantial material, that has fixed wings and one or two 7 remote-controlled, electric rotors." 8 9 SECTION 2. Section 706-606.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: 10 "(1) Notwithstanding section 706-669 and any other law to 11 the contrary, any person convicted of murder in the second 12 degree, any class A felony, any class B felony, or any of the 13 following class C felonies: 14 Section 134-7 relating to persons prohibited from 15 (a) owning, possessing, or controlling firearms or 16 ammunition; 17 (b) Section 134-8 relating to ownership, etc., of certain 18

- 1 mandatory minimum period of imprisonment without possibility of
- parole as provided in subsection (2)."
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
