A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 201B-7.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 " [{}§201B-7.5[{}] Applicability of Hawaii public
4 procurement code; convention center contractor; construction
5 contracts[-]; marketing contracts. (a) The construction
6 contracts for the maintenance of the convention center facility
7 by the private contractor that operates the convention center,
8 by its direct or indirect receipt of, and its expenditure of,
9 public funds from the department of business, economic
10 development, and tourism or the authority, or both, shall be
11 subject to part III of chapter 103D.

12 (b) The authority shall include performance-based
13 incentives in its professional services contracts consistent
14 with the State's marketing plan."

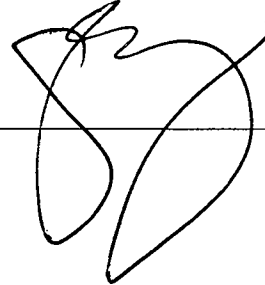
