- 1 SECTION 1. Section 201B-7.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+] §201B-7.5[+] Applicability of Hawaii public
- 4 procurement code; convention center contractor; construction
- 5 contracts[-]; professional services contracts. (a) The
- 6 construction contracts for the maintenance of the convention
- 7 center facility by the private contractor that operates the
- 8 convention center, by its direct or indirect receipt of, and its
- 9 expenditure of, public funds from the department of business,
- 10 economic development, and tourism or the authority, or both,
- 11 shall be subject to part III of chapter 103D.
- 12 (b) The authority shall include performance-based
- 13 incentives in its professional services contracts consistent
- 14 with the State's marketing plan."
- 15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
