A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the current language
- 2 of section 291C-194, Hawaii Revised Statutes, "[d]river's
- 3 license required, " has created confusion for law enforcement
- 4 regarding its applicability. This section relates specifically
- 5 to moped operation and the requirement to possess and present a
- 6 valid driver's license upon request by a police officer.
- 7 Section 291C-194 is necessary to define the immediate license
- 8 possession requirement specifically for moped operation and
- 9 align with the same requirement for operators of all other motor
- 10 vehicles covered under section 286-116, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 11 "[1]icense, insurance identification card, possession,
- 12 exhibition".
- The legislature recognizes, however, that as currently
- 14 written section 291C-194 could also be interpreted to conflict
- 15 with section 286-102, "[1]icensing", which requires a driver of
- 16 a moped to be properly licensed to operate a moped.

- 1 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to amend section
- 2 291C-194, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to clarify that this law
- 3 relates specifically to the requirement for an operator of a
- 4 moped to have in their immediate physical possession their
- 5 current driver's license or motorcycle permit and to present it
- 6 to a police officer upon demand.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 291C-194, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by amending the title and subsection (a) to read as
- 9 follows:
- 10 "§291C-194 Driver's license possession; required. (a) No
- 11 person shall drive a moped unless the person[+
- 12 (1) Possesses a valid driver's license of any category
- 13 listed in section 286 102 or 286 239; and
- 14 (2) Meets the requirements of section 286-105(3).
- 15 is in immediate possession of a valid driver's license or
- 16 instruction permit at all times."
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 18 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 19 begun before its effective date.
- 20 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
