A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WORKS OF ART SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) The works of art special fund shall be used solely
4 for the following purposes:

5 (1) Costs related to the acquisition of works of art,
6 including any consultant or staff services required to
7 carry out the art in public places and relocatable
8 works of art programs;

9 (2) Site modifications, display, and interpretive work
10 necessary for the exhibition of works of art;

11 (3) Upkeep services, including maintenance, repair, and
12 restoration of works of art;

13 (4) Storing and transporting works of art[-];

14 provided that not less than per cent of the expenditures of
15 the funds in the works of art special fund in each fiscal year
16 shall be for the commissioning of statues at new state
17 buildings."




