A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NOMINATION PAPERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 12-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§12-2.5 Nomination papers; when available.** Nomination
4 papers shall be made available from the first working day of
5 ~~[March]~~ April in every even-numbered year; provided that in the
6 case of a special primary or special election, nomination papers
7 shall be made available at least ten days before the close of
8 filing."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.


11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
12 provided that:

- 13 (1) This Act shall be repealed on the same date that
14 section 4 of Act 14, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, is
15 repealed; and



1 (2) On the date this Act is repealed, section 12-2.5,
2 Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted pursuant
3 to section 9 of Act 14, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021.
