A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that given expanding
- 2 telework options and infrastructure, the hiring of entirely
- 3 remote professionals for certain positions within the department
- 4 of education has the potential to satisfy critical hiring needs
- 5 in a fiscally prudent manner. This is particularly applicable
- 6 to positions in the areas of information technology and online
- 7 learning, as well as other highly specialized positions.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to help satisfy critical hiring
- 9 needs in a fiscally prudent manner by exempting certain
- 10 department of education employees from the state residency
- 11 requirement under section 78-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, part III, subpart B, Hawaii
- 13 Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be
- 14 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 15 "§302A- Personnel exempt from state residency
- 16 requirement. Beginning July 1, 2022, the department may recruit

1	and employ	y professionals for services contracted outside of the
2	State wit	hout regard to section 78-1(c); provided that:
3	(1)	The superintendent determines that the position is
4		capable of being performed entirely remotely and
5		provides to the board the factual basis for this
6		determination;
7	(2)	The superintendent determines that the position is a
8		critical hiring need of the department and provides to
9		the board the factual basis for this determination;
10	(3)	The superintendent determines that an exemption from
11		the state residency requirement under section 78-1(c)
12		is in the fiscal interests of the department and
13		provides to the board the factual basis for this
14		<pre>determination;</pre>
15	(4)	The board, in its discretion and by a majority of its
16		members, approves the exemption request; and
17	<u>(5)</u>	This exemption shall not apply to teachers."
18	SECTION 3. Section 78-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
19	amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:	
20	"(f)	This section shall not apply to persons recruited and
21	employed :	by the University of Hawaii under the authority of

- 1 section [+]304A-1001[+] and persons recruited and employed by
- 2 the department of education under the authority of section
- **3** <u>302A-</u>"
- 4 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2051.
