A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-121, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) The board shall consist of nine members as follows: 4 (1)One member from the county of Hawaii; 5 (2) One member from the county of Maui; 6 (3) One member from the county of Kauai; 7 (4)Three members from the city and county of Honolulu; 8 and 9 Three at-large members[; provided that the governor (5) 10 shall select an at-large member as the chairperson]. 11 The members shall be appointed by the governor, with the advice 12 and consent of the senate. The governor may remove or suspend 13 for cause any member of the board." SECTION 2. Section 302A-124, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 15 amended by amending its title and subsection (a) to read as 16 follows:

1 "[{]\$302A-124[}] Board of education; [organization;] 2 election of chairperson and vice chairperson; quorum; meetings. 3 (a) [The governor shall select a chairperson of the board; provided that the chairperson shall be selected from among the 5 at-large members.] The members shall elect, by simple majority, 6 a chairperson of the board from among its members. The board 7 shall [select] elect, by simple majority, a vice chairperson 8 from among its members[, and the]. The vice chairperson shall serve as interim chairperson in the event of the chairperson's 9 10 absence or if the chairperson's seat becomes vacant." 11 SECTION 3. Section 302A-125, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 amended to read as follows: 13 "[+]\$302A-125[+] Board of education; vacancies. (a) 14 governor shall notify the senate in writing within ten days of: 15 (1)Removing a member of the board; or 16 (2) Receiving notification that a member of the board is 17 resigning or has died; 18 provided that any vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the 19 governor, with the advice and consent of the senate, in 20 accordance with sections 302A-121, 302A-122, 302A-123, 302A-126,

and 302A-127.

2	governor [may nominate a sitting member of the board to the

4	shall fill any resulting vacancy in accordance with subsection

6	this vacancy, a new chairperson shall be elected by the members

10	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
