# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FOWL.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that feral chickens and
- 2 roosters are a persistent nuisance in urban and suburban
- 3 communities throughout the State. Feral chickens and roosters
- 4 trespass into yards and gardens, dig up plants, damage food
- 5 crops, and jeopardize native plants. Feral roosters are also a
- 6 noise nuisance, as they crow at all times of the day and night,
- 7 which has led to numerous complaints throughout the State.
- 8 These feral fowls also create road hazards for drivers who must
- 9 suddenly stop or swerve to avoid them on roadways.
- 10 The legislature further finds that unsanitary droppings and
- 11 aviary parasites from these birds are a health concern. Feral
- 12 chickens carry diseases that threaten or kill native Hawaiian
- 13 birds. There is also a risk that feral chickens will spread
- 14 disease to domestic fowl and to other wild birds.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to establish a pilot program to
- 16 manage the population of feral chickens in the State.
