### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MINIMUM WAGE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 387, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y adding one new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to rea	ad as follows:
4	" <u>§38</u> "	7- Minimum wage commission. (a) There is
5	establish	ed within the department a minimum wage commission, for
6	administr	ative purposes only. Members of the commission shall
7	include b	ut not be limited to the following:
8	(1)	The director or the director's designee;
9	(2)	The director of human services or the director's
10		designee;
11	(3)	Two members appointed by the governor;
12	(4)	Two members appointed by the president of the senate;
13	(5)	Two members appointed by the speaker of the house of
14		representatives; and
15	(6)	Three other representatives appointed by the governor
16		from other organizations that may assist in providing
17		necessary expertise.

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1	(b) Vacancies in a position shall be filled in the same		
2	manner as that member's appointment. The members of the		
3	commission shall serve without compensation but may be		
4	reimbursed for necessary expenses, including travel expenses,		
5	incurred in the discharge of their duties.		
6	(c) The commission shall review and recommend an		
7	appropriate minimum wage.		
8	(d) Before the twentieth legislative day of the regular		
9	session of 2023 and every year thereafter, the commission shall		
10	study and make recommendations for any increase in the minimum		
11	wage and the recommended effective date of the increase;		
12	provided that the recommended effective date shall be no earlier		
13	than the adjournment of the legislative session following the		
14	commission's recommendation. A recommended increase by the		
15	commission shall be effective as of the date set forth in the		
16	recommendation unless the legislature disapproves the		
17	recommendation by adoption of a concurrent resolution prior to		
18	adjournment sine die of the legislative session in which the		
19	recommendation was submitted."		
20	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general		
21	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so		

- 1 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 2 the administration of the minimum wage commission pursuant to
- 3 this Act.
- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 5 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
