A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FORENSIC TESTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that much progress has
- 2 been made to decrease the backlog of rape kit testing in the
- 3 State and speed up other forensic tests to assist law
- 4 enforcement in its duties. Statutes of limitations require that
- 5 timely testing is an obligation of the State to protect the
- 6 rights and safety of its citizens. Act 207, Session Laws of
- 7 Hawaii 2016, made a substantial impact on reducing the backlog.
- 8 However, there are still not adequate forensic testing resources
- 9 in Hawaii.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to provide funding for the State
- 11 to conduct forensic testing.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 as a
- 15 grant-in-aid to the city and county of Honolulu for forensic
- 16 testing resources, including equipment and personnel, for the
- 17 Honolulu police department.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the city and
- 2 county of Honolulu for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 as a
- 6 grant-in-aid to the county of Hawaii for forensic testing
- 7 resources, including equipment and personnel, for the Hawaii
- 8 police department.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the county of
- 10 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 as a
- 14 grant-in-aid to the county of Maui for forensic testing
- 15 resources, including equipment and personnel, for the Maui
- 16 police department.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the county of
- 18 Maui for the purposes of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
- 20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 21 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 as a



- 1 grant-in-aid to the county of Kauai for forensic testing
- 2 resources, including equipment and personnel, for the Kauai
- 3 police department.
- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the county of
- 5 Kauai for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
