A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PSYCHOLOGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that properly licensed
3	school psychologists provide effective services to help children
4	and youth succeed academically, socially, behaviorally, and
5	emotionally by providing direct educational and mental health
6	services for children and youth, as well as working with
7	parents, educators, and other professionals to create supportive
8	learning and social environments for all children.
9	Hawaii is the only state without certification or licensure
10	for school psychologists. As a result of the State's lack of
11	regulation of school psychologists, the State is unable to seek
12	reimbursements from the federal medicaid program for the use of
13	school psychologists in an educational setting.
14	However, further consideration must be given to determine
15	whether school psychologists should be regulated and, if so, the
16	appropriate form of any such regulation.

- 1 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the
- 2 auditor to perform a sunrise analysis of the proposed regulation
- 3 of school psychologists.
- 4 SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding the requirement of a
- 5 referring concurrent resolution pursuant to section 26H-6,
- 6 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the auditor shall analyze the probable
- 7 effects of a proposed regulatory measure to regulate the
- 8 profession of school psychologists in Hawaii and assess whether
- 9 its enactment is consistent with the policies under section 26H-
- 10 2, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The proposed measure to be analyzed
- 11 shall be S.B. No. 2281, S.D. 2, H.D. 1 (regular session of
- 12 2022). The auditor shall analyze, at minimum, the issues
- 13 entailed in the definition of school psychologist, description
- 14 of services delivered by a school psychologist, and mandatory
- 15 advisement to the board of psychology from a private
- 16 organization; and make recommendations on whether school
- 17 psychologists should be regulated.
- 18 (b) The auditor shall consider alternatives to the
- 19 proposed regulation, as appropriate.

- 1 (c) The auditor shall submit a report of the analyses
- 2 requested in this Act to the legislature no later than twenty
- 3 days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2024.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2060.

Report Title:

School Psychologists; Licensure; Auditor; Sunrise Analysis

Description:

Requires the auditor to conduct a sunrise analysis on a proposal to regulate school psychologists. Requires the auditor to submit a report to the legislature by 2024. Effective 7/1/2060. (HD2)

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
