## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MICROBEADS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that plastic microbeads
- 2 in many beauty products are harmful to coral and marine life.
- 3 Plastic microbeads can enter the ocean when they come off the
- 4 skin of swimmers, or through the sewer system when they are
- 5 eventually washed off in the shower, as they are too small to be
- 6 filtered out by most treatment facilities, and can often absorb
- 7 chemicals and toxins found in water along the way. Plastic
- 8 microbeads can enter the ocean by the billions, which are then
- 9 ingested by marine life, passing up through the food chain to
- 10 the humans who eat fish.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to phase in a prohibition on the
- 12 manufacture and sale in the State of certain personal care
- 13 products and non-prescription drugs that contain plastic
- 14 microbeads. The legislature notes that nothing in this Act
- 15 shall be construed to apply to rinse-off cosmetics and rinse-off
- 16 cosmetics that are also non-prescription drugs, as these

- 1 products are exclusively regulated by the federal government
- 2 pursuant to the federal Microbead-Free Waters Act of 2015.
- 3 SECTION 2. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 5 designated and to read as follows:
- 6 "§321- Prohibition of plastic microbeads; personal care
- 7 products; non-prescription drugs. (a) Beginning July 1, 2022,
- 8 no person shall manufacture in the State a personal care
- 9 product, except for a non-prescription drug, that contains
- 10 plastic microbeads.
- 11 (b) Beginning July 1, 2023, no person shall:
- 12 (1) Sell or offer for sale in the State a personal care
- product, except for a non-prescription drug, that
- 14 contains plastic microbeads; or
- 15 (2) Manufacture in the State a non-prescription drug that
- 16 <u>contains plastic microbeads.</u>
- 17 (c) Beginning July 1, 2024, no person shall sell or offer
- 18 for sale in the State a non-prescription drug that contains
- 19 plastic microbeads.
- 20 (d) Nothing in this section shall be construed to apply to
- 21 any rinse-off cosmetic or rinse-off cosmetic that is also a non-

- 1 prescription drug as regulated pursuant to the federal
- 2 Microbead-Free Waters Act of 2015, Public Law 114-114.
- 3 (e) As used in this section:
- 4 "Personal care product" means an article intended to be
- 5 rubbed, poured, sprinkled, or sprayed on, introduced into, or
- 6 otherwise applied to the human body or any part thereof for
- 7 cleansing; beautifying; promoting hygiene or attractiveness; or
- 8 altering one's appearance, including skin care or sun protection
- 9 products; and any article intended for use as a component of the
- 10 article. "Personal care product" does not include any
- 11 prescription drug.
- 12 "Plastic microbead" means a plastic particle that is less
- 13 than five millimeters in size."
- 14 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 15 application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held
- 16 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 17 applications of the Act that can be given effect without the
- 18 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 19 of this Act are severable.
- 20 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 21 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

## Report Title:

Plastic Microbeads; Manufacture or Sale; Personal Care Products; Non-Prescription Drugs; Prohibition

## Description:

Beginning 7/1/2022, bans the manufacture of a personal care product, except a non-prescription drug, that contains plastic microbeads. Beginning 7/1/2023, bans the sale or offer for sale of a personal care product, except a non-prescription drug, that contains plastic microbeads. Beginning 7/1/2024, bans the sale or offer for sale of a non-prescription drug that contains plastic microbeads. Specifically exempts rinse-off cosmetics that are also non-prescription drugs regulated by the federal Microbead-Free Waters Act of 2015. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
