A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FREE COMMUNITY COLLEGES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 304A-401, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) The board of regents [~~may~~]:

4 (1) May charge resident and nonresident tuition fees for
5 regular courses of instruction at [~~any~~] the University
6 of Hawaii [~~campus, including any community college.~~]
7 at Manoa, Hilo, and West Oahu Campuses;

8 (2) Shall not charge students who qualify as residents
9 pursuant to section 304A-402 tuition for regular
10 courses of instruction at any community college
11 campus; and

12 (3) May charge students who do not qualify as residents
13 pursuant to section 304A-402 nonresident tuition fees
14 for regular courses of instruction at any community
15 college campus."

16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022, and
2 shall apply to tuition fees for fall 2023 semester and
3 thereafter.

Prohibits the University of Hawaii Board of Regents from charging qualified residents for community college tuition for regular courses of instruction. Authorizes the Board to charge certain students nonresident tuition community college fees for regular courses of instruction.
