A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 602-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§602-51 How constituted.** The intermediate appellate
4 court shall consist of a chief judge and [~~five~~] six associate
5 judges. The chief judge, who shall be specifically selected,
6 shall supervise the administrative duties of the court."

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$214,788 or so much
9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the
10 establishment of one permanent full time equivalent (1.0 FTE)
11 intermediate appellate court associate judge position.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
13 the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
