## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSTRUCTION COSTS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 464-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to
- 4 work in respect to any privately owned or privately controlled
- 5 one-storied building, dwelling, or structure, the estimated cost
- 6 of which does not exceed [\$40,000,] \$154,000, nor to any
- 7 privately controlled two-storied building, dwelling, or
- 8 structure, the estimated cost of which does not exceed
- 9 [\$35,000.] \$135,000. However, no structure, dwelling, or
- 10 building in which the principal structural members consist of
- 11 reinforced concrete or structural steel having riveted, bolted,
- 12 or welded connections shall be exempted from this chapter.
- 13 (b) The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to work
- 14 in respect to any privately owned or privately controlled one-
- 15 storied structure, which is used primarily as a residence, the
- 16 estimated cost of which does not exceed [\$50,000,] \$193,000, nor
- 17 to any privately owned or privately controlled two-storied

- 1 structure, which is used primarily as a residence, the cost of
- which does not exceed [\$45,000.] \$173,000."
- 3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

#### Report Title:

Construction; Professional Engineers, Architects, Surveyors and Landscape Architects; Exempted Structures

### Description:

Increases the dollar amounts of estimated construction costs for work done to certain structures that are exempt from the requirement that plans be prepared by a licensed professional engineer or architect.

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
