## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 356D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§356D- Landlord incentive program special fund;
- 5 established. (a) There is established in the state treasury
- 6 the landlord incentive program special fund into which shall be
- 7 deposited all appropriations made by the legislature to the
- 8 special fund, grants, gifts, and interest on moneys therein.
- 9 (b) The landlord incentive program special fund shall be
- 10 administered by the authority. Moneys in the special fund shall
- 11 be used to provide rent reimbursement incentives and to
- 12 reimburse land owners who participate in Hawaii public housing
- 13 authority voucher programs, including section 8 housing choice
- 14 vouchers, rapid rehousing vouchers, and permanent housing
- 15 vouchers, to cover repair costs of tenant-caused property damage
- 16 when the repair costs exceed the tenant's security deposit."

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to be
- 4 deposited into the landlord incentive program special fund.
- 5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the landlord
- 6 incentive program special fund the sum of \$ or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the
- 8 landlord incentive program.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii public
- 10 housing authority for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
