SECTION 1. Section 249-31.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

RELATING TO ANNUAL VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$249-31.5 Exemptions from registration fees for certain vehicles; disabled veterans. (a) A disabled veteran who: 4 5 (1) Is a resident of Hawaii; (2) Has been other than dishonorably discharged from the 7 United States uniformed armed forces; and (3) Is determined by the United States Department of 9 Veterans Affairs or its predecessor to have a service-10 connected [one hundred per cent] disability rating of 11 ten per cent or higher for compensation or a service-12 connected disability rating of [one hundred per cent,]
- 14 shall be exempt from payment of all annual vehicle registration
- 15 fees as required by section 249-31; provided that this exemption
- 16 shall not extend to any vehicle used for commercial purposes or
- 17 to more than one vehicle owned by the disabled veteran.
