BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 226-106, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to	o read as follows:
3	"§22	6-106 Affordable housing. Priority guidelines for the
4	provision	of affordable housing:
5	(1)	Seek to use marginal or nonessential agricultural
6		land, urban land, and public land to meet housing
7		needs of extremely low-, very low-, lower-, moderate-,
8		and above moderate-income households.
9	(2)	Encourage the use of alternative construction and
10		development methods as a means of reducing production
11		costs.
12	(3)	Improve information and analysis relative to land
13		availability and suitability for housing.
14	(4)	Create incentives for development [which] that would
15		increase home ownership and rental opportunities for
16		Hawaii's extremely low-, very low-, lower-, and

1		moderate-income households and residents with special
2		needs.
3	(5)	Encourage continued support for government or private
4		housing programs that provide low interest mortgages
5		to Hawaii's people for the purchase of initial
6		owner-occupied housing.
7	(6)	Encourage public and private sector cooperation in the
8		development of rental housing alternatives.
9	(7)	Encourage improved coordination between various
10		agencies and levels of government to deal with housing
11		policies and regulations.
12	(8)	Give higher priority to the provision of quality
13		housing that is affordable for Hawaii's residents and
14		less priority to development of housing intended
15		primarily for individuals outside of Hawaii.
16	(9)	Seek to use lands within the State that are leased to
17		the federal government or under federal government
18		control and that are to be returned to the State,
19		including lands that have been used to house former
20		military facilities, to meet housing needs of
