
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 342L, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§342L- Permits near aquifer prohibited. (a) Beginning
5 July 1, 2022, the department shall not issue a permit for a new
6 large capacity underground storage tank system mauka of the
7 underground injection control line; provided that a permit may
8 be issued by the department for purposes of repairing or
9 removing an existing underground storage tank.

10 (b) Beginning January 1, 2023, no person shall operate a
11 large capacity underground storage tank system mauka of the
12 underground injection control line, and no permit for a large
13 capacity underground storage tank system mauka of the
14 underground injection control line shall be renewed.

15 (c) As used in this section:

16 "Large capacity underground storage tank system" means an
17 underground storage tank system with any single tank with a



1 capacity greater than fifty thousand gallons or with a total
2 tank capacity greater than one hundred thousand gallons.

3 "Underground injection control line" means the underground
4 injection control line represented by a dashed line on the
5 department of health underground injection control program maps,
6 made effective July 6, 1984, and identified as follows:

7 (1) For the island of Hawaii, quadrangles H-1 to H-74;

8 (2) For the island of Kauai, quadrangles K-1 to K-11;

9 (3) For the island of Lanai, quadrangles L-North and

10 L-South;

11 (4) For the island of Maui, quadrangles M-1 to M-17;

12 (5) For the island of Molokai, quadrangles M-East and

13 M-West; and

14 (6) For the island of Oahu, quadrangles O-1 to O-15."

15 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Prohibits issuance of permits for future large capacity underground storage tank systems mauka of the underground injection control line beginning July 1, 2022. Prohibits operation of and renewal of large capacity underground storage tank system permits located mauka of the underground injection control line beginning January 1, 2023. (SD2)
