A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with article VII, section 9, of
- 3 the Hawaii State Constitution.
- 4 SECTION 2. The legislature finds that deer overpopulation
- 5 in the county of Maui has led to a state of emergency. Around
- 6 fifty thousand axis deer exist in Maui county and as many as
- 7 five hundred threaten the safety of Kahului airport. With the
- 8 recent events of deer entering onto the airport runway, in the
- 9 interest of safety, it is necessary that the State take
- 10 immediate action to replace the fence to secure the perimeter of
- 11 the airport.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to make an emergency
- 13 appropriation to provide funds to replace the perimeter fence
- 14 around Kahului airport. Without an emergency appropriation,
- 15 axis deer may continue to enter the airport runway creating a
- 16 substantial safety risk to airport passengers and operators.



- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$17,000,000 or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 to
- 4 construct a new perimeter fence at Kahului airport (OGG), in
- 5 Maui county.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
